1989 HEATER SYSTEMS Eagle Trouble Shooting

CONDITION & POSSIBLE CAUSE

Little or No Air From Heater Floor Outlets.

- * Misadjusted heater air door cable.
- * Obstructed heater housing or ducts.
- * Clogged heater core fins.
- * Leaking air duct seals.

Little or No Air From Defroster Outlets.

- * Defroster duct misaligned.
- * Defroster cable incorrectly adjusted
- * Leaking air duct seals.
- * Defroster duct damaged.

Heat Output When Controls Are Off.

- * Outside air cable misadjusted
- * Outside Air door binding in housing.

Not Enough Heat With Controls Fully On.

- * Low coolant or plugged heater core.
- * Incorrect thermostat.
- * Incorrect adjustment of cables.
- * Heater System Air Leaks.* Blend air door not in proper position.

Blower Will Not Run.

- * Blown fuse.
- * Loose connections or poor ground.
- * Faulty switch, motor or resistor.

Blower Runs But Does Not Circulate Air.

- * Intake blocked..
- * Fan not attached to motor shaft.
